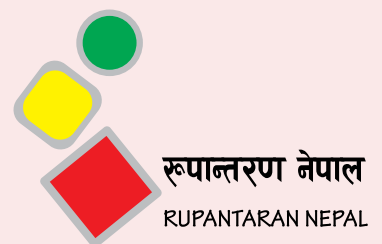

Rupantaran Nepal (RN) is a not for profit organization and registered to the Government of Nepal under company act, 2063 which has made a provision of registering and functioning of philanthropic organization. RN is dedicated to be an independent and neutral social enterprise, to bring out the best of an

NGO and a corporate organization. The organization is established by a group of Nepalese development professionals and social activists having diverse experience in Forestry Sector, Social Development, Livelihoods, Climate Change and Community Development.

## Programme at a Glance

Rupantaran Nepal (RN) works with communities, partners and government in across the Nepal and dedicated to transform people’s lives and living by mobilizing and managing resources, promoting social justice and nurturing collaboration. Our work is focused in the areas of Climate change, disaster and environment management, livelihoods and economic empowerment, Natural resource management including forest resource management,

monitoring, evaluation and learning, Stakeholder's capacity enhancement and Gender, social inclusion and governance. In ten years, RN managed 55 diversified assignments in which include project management, consultancy services and technical assistance to Government of Nepal, Multi and Bi-lateral Programme and Projects, International Non-Government Organization (INGOs) and National Non-Government Organization.

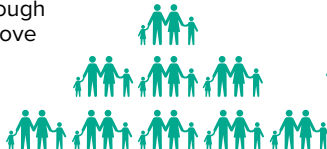
## Key Achievement towards Resilience

During the 12 years, RN worked with the total 178,931 poor and excluded right holders including 78353 women to improve their livelihoods and

resilience capacity to cope with shocks and stresses created by multiple factors including climate change, policies and social factors.

## Management of Assignment

RN managed 55 assignment including project management, consulting services and technical assistance. Out of 55 assignment almost 50% (27) of the assignment is focused to environment, climate change and disaster risk reduction theme, 18.18%

(10) of the assignment is focus to GESI, institutional development and governance and 15% assignment were focused to the forest resource management and 9% were monitoring, evaluation and learning.



## Partnership

During this period, RN has undertaken partnership and collaboration with multiple agencies and development partners working in the development

sector in Nepal. Likewise, RN provided consultancy services to various clients.

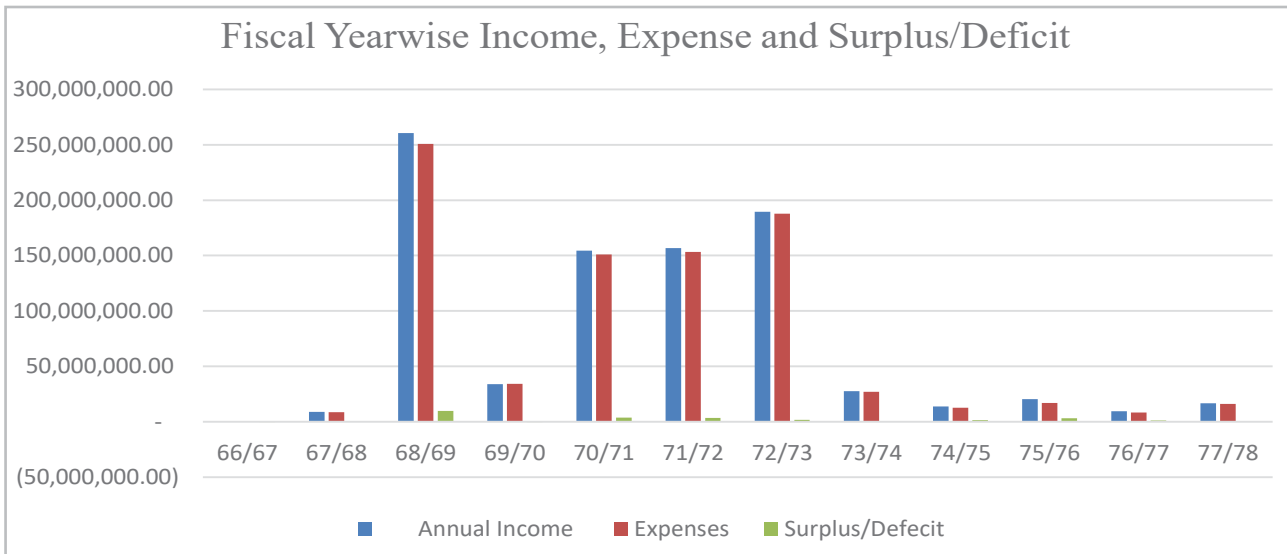


During this period, RN directly worked in partnership with 25 district based non-government organization. RN also strengthened their institutional capacity to perform effectively in delivery of the development project and program. Through its capacity building interventions, RN has supported to 122 NGOs for their capacity building.

## Financial Summary

In 12 years, RN has managed NPR 1,007,968,440.04 which is inclusive VAT. Within this tenure, NPR 15,970,642.97 of the surplus was generated. Total NPR 102,940,235

amount of VAT has been deposited to Inland Revenue office, Tangal and NPR 5,901,939.71 amount of income tax was deposited as an organization.



Most of the revenue were generated from the project, programme and consultancy services to Multi and Bi-lateral project/ programme, government led project and programme, INGOs, and NGOs. Some amount of the fund has been generated by donation from the member of Rupantaran Nepal.

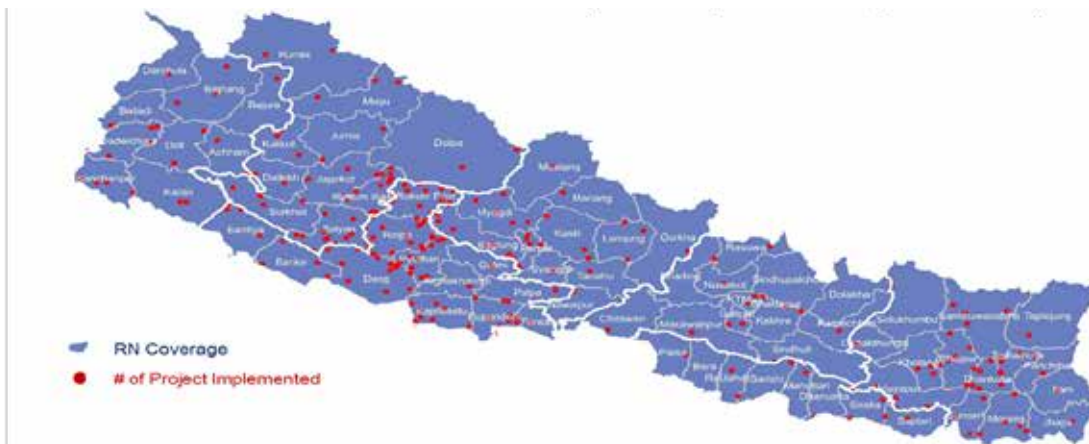
## Geographical Coverage

RN has demonstrated its geographical presence across Nepal. RN has covered all districts of Nepal through its direct project implement and consulting services as well as the partnership in the consortium.

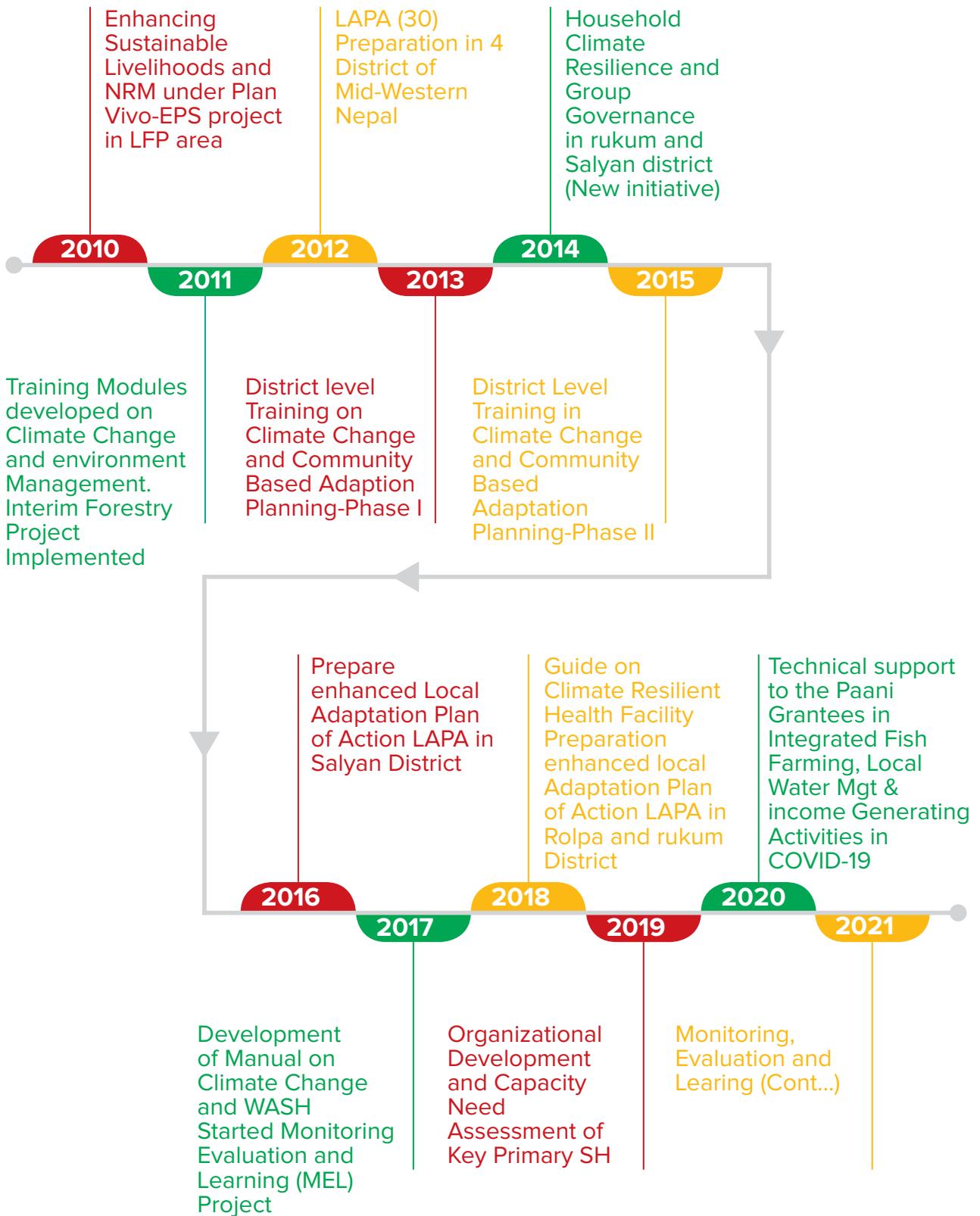
Geographical coverage of the RN is presented in below maps. The map demonstrated that RN has implemented multiple projects in Lumbini Province of Nepal.

District Coverage and Number of Projects Implemented (2010/2021)

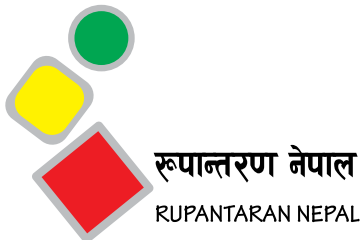


# Historical Timeline of Rupantaran Nepal
